Teaching format/class hours per week during the semester	The time allocation of students in the Community service with 3 (three) credits is 360 effective hours, consist of 72 hours for pre-implementation activities held on campus and 288 hours for the implementation of Community Service activities while staying at Community Service location (2 months). The implementation activities consist of at least 200 hours for main activities and at least 88 hours for auxiliary activities (activities to assist the implementation of the main program of Community Service participants in the same unit).
	The duration of the main activities at least 140 hours for the implementation of the theme and maximum 60 hours for non theme activities in accordance with their respective fields of activity. Under certain circumstances a Community Service participant is enabled to assist the implementation of the main program outside the unit with the approval of both Field Supervisors.
Workload	Community Service Course is implemented within 2 (two) months with the number of hours at least 288 (two hundred eighty eight) effective working hours for each student

Requirements	Students must have completed lectures and laboratory works of at least 100 (one hundred) credits without an E score.
Learning goals/ competencies	Community Service is organized to create students that able to: 1. Analyze problems and potentials in the community 2. Design an empowerment program 3. Manage interdisciplinary cooperation network 4. Implement empowerment program based on the potency of region and local wisdom 5. Formulate the performance accountability of the empowerment program based on accountability principle.
Content	Community Service Course is packaged in a particular theme and designed to address real issues facing the community (thematically) through interdisciplinary or multidisciplinary approaches and empowering local resources.
	Each theme is implemented by a Community Service unit consisting of 24-30 students from various faculties at Universitas Gadjah Mada.
	Implementation of KKN-PPM includes: 1. Pre-Implementation, including: Theme Selection and Proposal Submission, Participant Registration of Community Service, Debriefing, Taking individual equipment of Community Service participant, Permit submission of Community Service implementation activity to local government, Students placement, Consolidation of Community Service Unit, Taking Equipment / Package for Unit and Sub-unit, Briefing of Student Unit Coordinators, Delivery of Community Service fund (for transportation, living expenses, and Community Service program), Campus Service Activities, Community Service Release and Direction from Rector. 2. Implementation, including: Student Placement to Community Service Location, Field Operation, Student Withdrawal from Community Service Location. 3. Assessment, including: General Test Assessment by Lecturer of Debriefing and Evaluation of Student Performance by Field Supervisor.
